Participating in God's realm of distributive justice means a radical denial of our singularly self-interest. As we share this bread and cup, we share ourselves and make no distinction between them and us. We live within a deeply held common interest.

Please form, around the sanctuary, a circle symbolizing our one spirit, a symbol of Holy Presence with us. Today, we will serve one another as the Bread and Cup are passed. You may say, "Broken for you. *OR*, Jesus loves you!" You may say, "Poured out for you. *OR*, Cup of the new covenant."
