We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

**Our children are invited to remain in worship with us. The exception is first and third Sundays of the months during the program year when our families host "Children's Church" right after Kids' Time.**

***We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!***

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them.

**When your child (1<sup>st</sup> grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are...** you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.

**God, I know something about being pruned. I know what it feels like to be cut off or kept away from the people and things I love and are important to me. I “bear” no fruit when this happens...not for me, or You, or anybody!**

(Let there be some quiet. Go deeper....)

**Lord, at such times, I don’t feel "I abide in You and You in me." In such times, I often can’t even feel You at all. When life is cutting, here’s the thing: How am I to live joyfully (bear fruit when I’m being pruned)? How do I know where to turn (in whom to abide)? How do I know what to choose (the true vine)?**

*In a gentle self-reflective voice, let’s read/mumble together slowly with intention....a personal prayer read corporately for we are all much more alike than we are different! We may not read in unison as we will pause to “Go Deeper” for varying lengths of time.*

**You say, "Come to me." Lord, I long to come. When life is cutting and there are many low lying branches blocking my way, help me. Help me to distinguish between the pruning the world does which diminishes my life and the pruning You do which releases me and takes me beyond the mind I have...placing me on my way, The Way!**

**Lord, I ask it.**

**✧ A Moment With God For Each Of Us...**

*You may wish to name with God a way in which life cuts you off from the love you desire; or you may share how it feels not to be able to feel God abiding with you in the tough times OR how wondrously you do feel God's abiding presence in exactly those times; or you may simply invite Jesus to come sit beside you in the pew this morning shining his healing light all around and through you.*



Let there be some quiet. We will be "stilled" together for 5 minutes or so! You have time....go deeper....

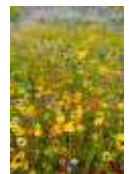
