Our church is a safe sanctuary for children...

We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

Our children are invited to remain in worship with us. The exception is first and third Sundays of the months during the program year when our families host

"Children's Church" right after Kids' Time.

We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them.

When your child (1st grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are...

you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.

"Palm Sunday's Passion"

Palm Sunday marks Christ's entrance into Jerusalem...triumphant but hardly the king they thought they were getting! As we move ever closer to the cross and the mystery of Easter Life, today's Bible Wisdom Teachings focus us on the events of Holy Week - The Passion of Christ: Jesus' arrest, trial, and crucifixion. They mark the lengths to which God calls the faithful, but also the constant presence of God with us and the enduring nature of God's purposes unfolding amongst us. We are made able...to welcome ...what comes next!

[On Palm Sunday we shared in Holy Communion together. We will not have it this week, but we will next Sunday, August 26.] All God's adults and children are welcome at Table no matter where you are on your own faith journey!
