#### We're Glad You've Come.

This is a safe place, a sanctuary of worship and prayer, comfort and justice-seeking for all God's people and all are welcome here ....just as you are.

**Our church is a safe sanctuary for children.** We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

<u>Our children are invited to remain in worship</u> <u>with us</u>. The exception is Second and Fourth Sundays of the months during the program year when Heatherlee guides "Children's Wisdom Circle: after Kids' Time.

> We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them.

### When your child (1<sup>st</sup> grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are...

you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.
