

This is a safe place, a sanctuary of worship and prayer, comfort and justice-seeking for all God's people and all are welcome here ...just as you are.

Our church is a safe sanctuary for children.

We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

Our children are invited to remain in worship with us. The exception is Second and Fourth Sundays of the months during the program year when Heatherlee guides

"Children's Wisdom Circle: after Kids' Time.

We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them.

When your child (1st grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are...

you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.





## Opening Ourselves to God's Grace

**Pastor:** We are on a path that takes us beyond Bethlehem. And, God's Word rises up against the messages of our world....messages that would have us believe we aren't good enough, smart enough, rich enough, certainly not precious enough! God tells us differently....Isaiah says so. We are chosen and redeemed before we are even born! We are precious and loved....beloved! But what will it take for us to live "loved" lives? It takes our letting God be parent, cheerleader, mentor....maker, lover, keeper of life. It takes belief enough to turn to God for the help we need so we can begin to see ourselves the way God sees us and claim our true identity. This letting go requires the support of community....baptism our sign of belonging, marking us in community...calling us to give as well as receive support to and from each other.

**One:** Each with our own beloved story shaped anew by the Holy Story, as we surrender pretenses and open to God, we lift our prayers silently to our God using the reflection on Page 5 to guide us.
