

This is a safe place, a sanctuary of worship and prayer, comfort and justice-seeking for all God's people and all are welcome here ...just as you are.

Our church is a safe sanctuary for children.

We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

Our children are invited to remain in worship with us. The exception is Second and Fourth Sundays of the months during the program year when Heatherlee guides

"Children's Wisdom Circle: after Kids' Time.

We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.

When your child (1st grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are... you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this.

Infant through 1st Grade Care

is available all during worship down the stairs in the Cloud Room which is our "nursery."

## Opening Ourselves to God's Grace

We say we believe God knows all things about us....knows our prayers before they even enter our awareness. Some may then say, "Why pray at all?" But there is a special internal response of spirit that happens when we voice our prayers, especially when we voice them out loud. Something within us "shifts".

Perhaps the burden of silence is harder for us to bear than we can know until we have broken the silence in voiced prayer. If we can begin to believe the scriptures' assertion that "we know that all things work together for good for those who love God", then we can begin to trust God will use whatever prayer we lift for "good"....for our good.

Each with our own beloved story shaped anew by the Holy Story, as we surrender pretenses and open to God, we lift our prayers to our God, out loud together, using the reflection on Page 4 to guide us.
