Our Confession, Our Longing, Our Call at This Holy Time

(During the pouring out of water, let us walk the circle counter clockwise around the sanctuary, within a Holy Hush opening ourselves to the Mystery! Please read the bold print.)

Oh Holy Oneness, we come before you with our lives bent,
our hearts kneeling, our minds struggling...

Take our dusty journeys, and wrap your hands round them.

Every path we have trodden in life:

Every work that has taken us to hurtful locations,
Every thought that has moved us toward the shadows,
Every act that has led us into rough places, wash away the pain,
as we confess and you forgive.

(Some water pours into the basin as we circle.)

Take the wounds of our traveling, and hold them in your healing hands:

Every journey of remembrance that holds too many memories,
Every burden we carry that weighs us with anger we cannot let go,
Every place we have visited that holds too much pain.
Wash away the lingering, as we let go, and let You heal.

(Some water pours into the basin as we circle.)

Take the discomfort of our values, and wash and wipe and cleanse us as You serve us:

**Every lesson about love we have not learned,
Every heavenly value we have not grasped,
Every truth of Your Realm we have ignored.
Wash away our hesitation so we may be reshaped
by the great passion of this week's story.**

(Some water pours into the basin as we circle.)

Jesus says:

Come, you who are weary, you who are heavy laden. Come and be refreshed.

Hear my command: Love one another as I have loved you. I love you.

I have come to serve...with you. In serving each other, we face the risks and are filled with revelation!
