What is White Fragility?

White fragility is a state in which even a minimum amount of racial stress becomes intolerable, triggering a triangle of defensive moves. These moves include the outward display of emotions such as anger, fear, and guilt, and behaviors such as argumentation, silence, and leaving the stress-inducing situation. White Fragility is the thing that restricts our knowledge, shuts down conversations before they start, and invites us to lie to ourselves about why we do this.

This discussion will center on developing strategies to deal with white fragility by recognizing it when it appears in our conversations and in our thinking. Then, construct ways to recover and overcome the behaviors.
