## Lenten Readings from the Gospel of Truth:

### **The Gospel of Truth 1:1, 3**

“The good news of truth is joy for those who received grace from the God of the truth; that they might know God through the power of the Word which has come from the fullness (wholeness) and is the thought and mind of God. And the name “good news” is the revelation of hope, for this is the discovery of those who see God.”

### **The Gospel of Truth 2:1-5, 3:4, 4:1**

“All things have searched for the One from whom they have come. All things were within the One—the uncontainable, incomprehensible One who surpasses all thought. Ignorance (of the One) produced disturbance and fear, and disturbance enveloped like a mist so that no one was able to see. In this way Transgression found strength, and fashioned materiality with emptiness. Transgression did not know the truth and became a molded form, preparing—in power and beauty—a substitute for truth. (The) Forgetfulness (of Transgression) came into being because the Father was not known, so when the Father comes to be known, forgetfulness, from that time on, will not exist. This is the good news of the one (Jesus Christ) whom they see, revealed to those filled through the mercies of the Father. Through hidden mystery, Jesus Christ shone to the ones in the darkness of forgetfulness. Jesus Christ enlightened them and showed them a way. The Way Jesus taught them is truth.”

### **The Gospel of Truth 18:1-11**

“Be concerned with yourselves. Do not be concerned with things you have cast from yourselves. Do not return to eat what you have vomited. Do not be rotten. Do not be worms, for you have already shaken it off. Do not become a place for the ‘devil’, for you have already left the “devil” barren. Do not strengthen barriers that are falling away, for support. For the lawless person does his works as a lawless *one* and the just person does his work *among others*. Do then what the Father desires, for you are from Him.”

### **The Gospel of Truth 9:7-9; 16:1, 2, 6, 7b, 10**

“The Father opens His bosom and His bosom is the Holy Spirit. The Father reveals His hidden self—His hidden self is His Child—so that through the compassion of the Father the generations might know Him and ‘finding Him is rest’. Knowledge of the Father and the revelation of His Child gave them means of knowing. For when they saw the Child and heard the Child, the Father let them taste and smell and touch the Beloved Child. The Child spoke new things while speaking what is in the Father’s heart and brought out the faultless Word. The Child gave them thought and understanding, compassion and salvation, and the spirit of power in the Father’s boundlessness and sweetness. The Child became a way for those who strayed and knowledge for those who were ignorant, discovery for those searching, and strength for those who were shaken, purity for those who were defiled.”
