As you enter, please use this time to greet friends, welcome newcomers, and join in the spirit of community.



Those times were as turbulent as these times... or, is that the other way around. Both potentially...deadly!

But Lord, You know, I like the story of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem at the beginning of this week...with the "crowd shouting" and the "palms waving," a lot better than the story of Jesus' betrayal, trial, and impending death at this week's end. Couldn't we just skip over that last part? After all, isn't the point of Easter resurrection and not crucifixion?
