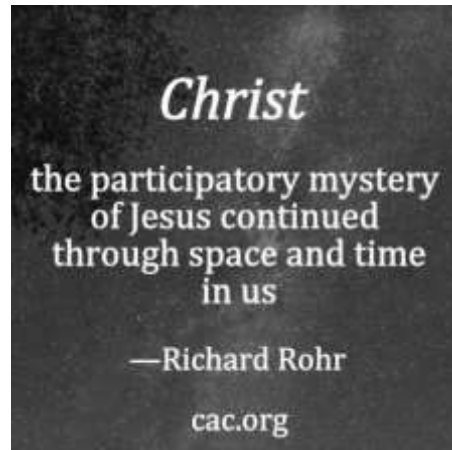
As you enter, please use this time to greet friends, welcome newcomers, and join in the spirit of community.

Can I think out loud with you, God? I am beginning to get it. As Jesus lives it, "love" is not an emotion but an act of the will.

*Listen NOW! Listen remembering what is often most needed is for us to be saved from...ourselves!*

*You are invited to join in reading out loud the psalm.*

*One of the ways our story is told!*

*Feel free to write in the margins! Use this space for your personal reflections!*

*Deeply hear this invitation.*

*A silent prayer for each of us based on our Wisdom Teachings.*

When Jesus tells me to love my neighbors, He is not telling me to love them with a cozy emotional feeling. He's not telling me to be "nice"! Jesus is telling me to do something!

Jesus is telling me to love my neighbor in the sense of being willing to work for their well-being even if it means sacrificing my usual ways of doing things....my habits and prejudices! In a sense then, O Holy One, I can love my neighbor without necessarily liking or agreeing with them. Good news! It's hard to like everyone and it's hard to live so others will always like me.

Keep me from being an overprotective sentimentalist!  
Lead me in the path of love that calls me to be an honest friend.

Help to walk the talk of faith and learn a new way of the heart.  
Help me become aware of my daily patterns of inclusion and exclusion, and then help me risk changing them!

Pull me out of time *NOW!*

Lord, You hear my prayer time after time...  
may my timing be *NOW!*
