- Safe and nurturing environment for our children offering extended before and after camp care

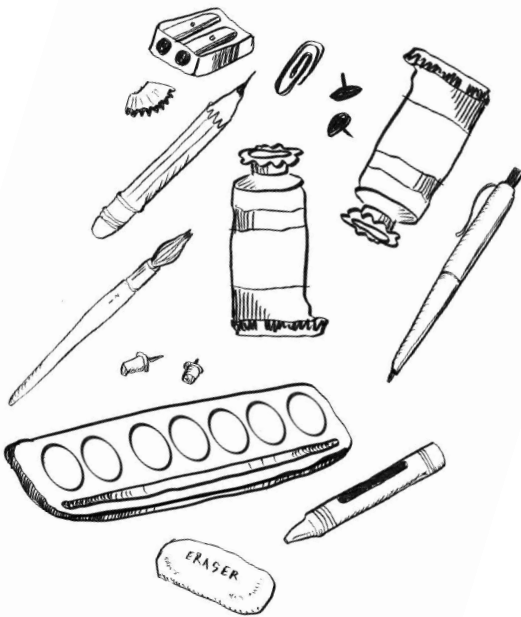

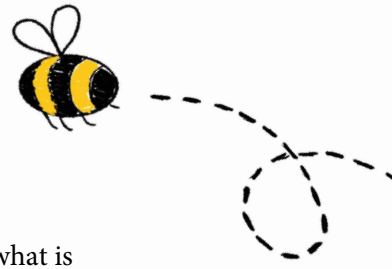

Aug 9-13 Life in and Around the Pond

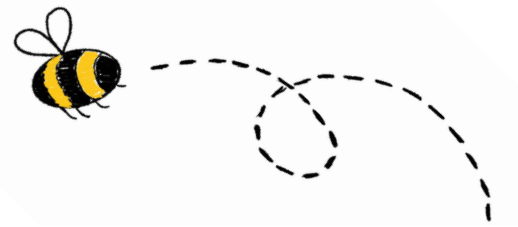
Join us as we explore the Saveland Park pond through observations, sketching, Pleine Air painting while checking out all the birds, dragonflies, frogs, and fish!
