Lord, I close my eyes in order not to see my parents tired, my brothers and sisters alone and lonely, my friends and loved ones sad with no one to console them. I close my eyes...so I don't have to see *myself*.

I am like a blind person...because sometimes it's all just too much to see! I pretend that I am safe by simply not seeing what is at hand.

I close my eyes in order not to see you, Lord...see You encouraging and inviting me to throw off these cloaks of mine and follow You. I want to see You.

If only I had the confidence to call out for sight. If only I was sure I could handle what I might see. I so want to hear the disciples respond to my calling out, saying: "Take heart: get up, he is calling you."

Have mercy on me, Lord! For sometimes I struggle to see the things in life that shine with Your goodness. Pull me out of the dark into which I escape. Even if I can't call out, come to me with light so I will open my eyes, and see You....and joyfully follow You toward my brothers and sisters...toward new life! Lord God, re-form me and I will re-form my life.

*O Merciful One, this is my prayer for awareness.*

*You hear my prayer.*

*(Release a sigh...)*



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✧ You may wish to name with God how you close your eyes...fleeing to the seeming safety of "not looking"; or you may ask God to help you be re-formed in newness and grace; or you may simply invite Jesus to come sit beside you in the pew this morning shining his healing light all around and through you.

## Opening Ourselves To God's Grace

This is Reformation Sunday. We celebrate how Martin Luther reformed the church in 1517 by posting his "95 Theses" ....making the Bible accessible to all people and changing the roles of pastors and parishioners forever. He reformed the church just as Jesus reformed the temple. Actually, what each wanted to do was re-form individuals and open up the wonders of God and faith for everyone. Now it's our turn to do the re-forming! And we begin by re-forming ourselves!

Re-forming ourselves is dependent upon seeing ourselves as we really are...and aren't.  
Re-forming ourselves means facing the fact God loves us just the way we are...and aren't.  
God loves us and there is nothing we can do about it...but in-joy it!
